Royal International Miss State Pageant Information

Areas of competition

Our state pageant offers two styles of titles to celebrate the diverse talents of our delegates. The Miss North Carolina and South Carolina titles are part of the Royal International Miss competition, while the Miss North Carolina and South Carolina Role Model titles are judged based on the Royal International Miss Role Model areas. Each title is equally prestigious & valued.

Royal International Miss North Carolina & South Carolina State title

The delegates chosen for the Miss North Carolina and South Carolina divisional titles will go on to compete in the 2025 International competition to be held in Orlando, FL. These delegates also have the choice to sign up to compete In the International Role Model competition.

The Royal International Miss divisional areas of competition include:

Interview

30% of total score

Once registered, each delegate will receive an Interview resume that will be turned in at registration, please bring 4 copies. Judges will reference your resume to ask standard "get to know you" style questions during interview. Please also email your resume to the director 30 days prior to the pageant date.

Princess and Sweetheart will participate in a seated, round robin interview.

Each delegate will have 1 minute with each of our judges.

Full hair and makeup is allowed for all ages.

Pre-teen & up will sit with the judges for a 2-minute panel style interview.

Introduction

30% of total score

This Introduction will take place on stage Sunday at the Recital Hall. Time limit is <u>45 seconds</u>. We will allow a 3 second grace period, but deductions will take place once the timer reaches 49 seconds.

Evening Gown

40% of total score

All delegates are asked to wear a long dress to compete in. We do not recommend any "cupcake" style dress. Delegates will be judged on First Impression, Poise, Presentation and Overall Appearance.

Walking pattern will be provided below. Time limit will be 90 seconds.

Royal International Miss North Carolina & South Carolina Role Model title

Anyone competing for the Royal International Miss Role Model title will be committing to compete in the Royal International Miss Role Model competition, in Orlando, at Internationals. The Royal International Miss Role Model Program aims to inspire community service within our local communities while also helping our delegates develop lifelong communication skills. At our state pageant, you will compete in different areas of competition than you will at Internationals.

The Royal International Role Model areas of competition include:

Interview

40% of total score

This will be a separate 2-minute panel-style interview focused on your community service experiences, leadership skills, and scholastic activities that contribute to being a good Role Model. The interview will be conducted while sitting, and questions will be generated based on your Resume form from the Divisional competitions.

Introduction

30% of total score

This score will carry over from your Divisional competitions.

Evening Gown

30% of total score

This score will carry over from your Divisional competitions.

What is expected If I win?

Royal International Miss is a title NOT a crown. We want you to use your title throughout the year by getting involved in community service.

If you are crowned with any of our titles at State, you are expected to advance to compete at the International Pageant in 2025. There is not a non-compete clause at the state level, but there is one on the International level.

We will crown up to 7 North Carolina and South Carolina state queens, and up to 7 North Carolina and South Carolina Role Model queens. The cost for Internationals is \$395 for Entry Fee, and \$800 for the Ad Page/Scholarship Fee. (This will be paid in four, \$200 monthly installments.) If you win one of our state titles you receive the following discount for Internationals:

- North Carolina and South Carolina (\$395 off Entry Fee)
- North Carolina and South Carolina Role Model (\$345 off Entry Fee)

State Registration process

1. Go to www.royalinternationalmiss.com and register by clicking on your State. Fill out the information and pay your \$30 Registration Fee. This Registration fee also includes your black Royal International Miss bling shirt that will be worn throughout the year.

- 2. You will then receive a confirmation of entry email from along with additional paperwork.
- 3. Pay half of your \$395 entry fee by December 15th. Final payments on your state entry fee, not including optional competitions, will be due January 5th. Payment information will be found on the Registration Fees Page.
- <u>4.</u> Optional competitions can be paid for in advance, or at the door. Payment information will be found on the Registration Fees Page.
- <u>5.</u> Go to Facebook to friend request state director TraciRenAe (Tracy McRae), and international staff Sharon Nordquist and Jeff LeForce.

Styles of questions for Divisional Interview

Black Bling Shirt

You will wear this shirt during rehearsals and throughout the year. You will receive the weekend of the pageant and your size will be notated after registration.

Interview is to explain who YOU are. At state, we will use your resume to generate questions along with questions similar to these.

Do you play sports?
What grade are you in?
What do you do with your family?
Why do you like pageants?

Who do you look up to? What do you want to be? Do you have a platform? Why do you want to win?

At the Internationals, your Divisional Interview questions will come straight from the Personal Introduction that you deliver on stage.



Styles of questions for Role Model Interview

This interview is based on your Community Service experiences. Your Resume will provide the basis for some questions, but you may also see questions similar to the ones below.

Why do you like to help others? Do you have a platform? What is your favorite way to give back? Who is your Role Model? What does it mean to be a Role Model?

Hair and Makeup rules for **STATE**

At state, all delegates are allowed hair and makeup for all areas of competition. We do ask that you keep it age appropriate. Eyelashes and extensions are allowed.
